



Challenge Option: Read Every Day

Reading during summer helps children maintain or improve their reading skills depending on the amount of time spent reading. **This summer, every student is challenged to read or be read to, for 25 minutes each day!** Keep track of your minutes in a notebook or on your computer. Bring in your log sheets or notebooks, on drop-in day (Friday, August 28), or for pre-school students, your first day of school, or e-mail them to Mrs. Marach at cindy.marach@menomoniecatholic.org. **Rewards will be given to those students who participate.**

Challenge Option: Read and Write with World Book Online

A second option is reading and writing with World Book five days a week. St. Joseph School subscribes to World Book online. Click [HERE](#), or on the bottom blue button on the School webpage. Login ID is: scholar. The password is: saintjoes. This log in information is also posted on Sycamore. **Please do not share our login and password for this product.**

Students are familiar with World Book from the computer lab. Additional features on the “Kids” version include games and activities. The “Student” version offers trivia, current events and interactive maps.

Students can choose a letter from the alphabet and look up something that begins with the letter chosen. Then:

- * Students finishing K, 1, 2, write **two or three sentences** on what you have read
- * Students finishing 3, 4, 5, 6 write **four or five good sentences** on what you have read
- * Pre-School students can draw a picture and tell an adult what it is about
- * Please include on your paper/spiral/document Name; Date; Article Name

Children should write their sentences as best as they can on their own documenting the article name and something of interest to them they found in the article.

Use the Public Library’s Resources:

Books read in the public library challenge can also be used on the St. Joseph log sheets. The public library offers great programming and supports families through reading, teaching responsibility, and spending time together. Something for everyone in the family can be found at the public library.

Please encourage your child to read every day.
